To use the Oral Reading Fluency Ongoing Progress Monitoring (ORF – OPM) for grades 1-5 follow the guidelines below to determine which grade level to use and which students you want to progress monitored more frequently than the three times a year.

Once you have a grade level, you can select any passage within that grade level using the chart below. Next, calculate a fluency score on the passage using the formula at the bottom of the passage. Once you have calculated fluency, click on the look up table for the corresponding grade level. Use the passage number (P1, P2, P3, etc.) across the top of the sheet to find the correct column. Find the student's fluency score in that column and then look to the left to the first two columns. The first column will provide the student's percentile when compared to other students at that grade level. The second column will provide the adjusted fluency score.

The adjusted fluency score adjusts the score for difficulty level so you can use the score to compare across passages and across time. This adjusted score allows you to determine if there was growth in fluency because you can estimate the passages were of 'equal' difficulty.

## For ORF Placement decisions for Grades 1-2, use the following rules:

- o First Grade: OPM ORF is only available if:
  - Student has successfully read Passage 4 of 1<sup>st</sup> grade BDI (Cake) at 90% accuracy or a passage higher in the sequence than Passage 4 (Cake)
  - Then the student is placed into a first grade OPM passage and only 1<sup>st</sup> grade passages
  - Only one passage per 20 instructional days

## o Second Grade: OPM ORF is only available if:

- Student has successfully read Passage 4 of 1<sup>st</sup> grade BDI (Cake) at 90% accuracy or a passage higher in the sequence than Passage 4 (Cake) or they have completed a second grade passage.
- If the second grade student read a second grade passage on the BDI, then the student is placed into a second grade OPM ORF passage.
- If the student moves back to a first grade passage on BDI, and reads Passage 4 (Cake) or higher with 90% accuracy, then the student is placed into a first grade OPM ORF passage and will remain in first grade passages until the next AP when the next BDI is taken again.
- Only one passage per 20 instructional days

## For ORF Placement decisions for Grades 3-5, use the following rules:

- o If TDI Maze Percentile Score > 40<sup>th</sup>, no progress monitoring available
- o If TDI Maze Percentile Score =  $31^{st} 40^{th}$  percentile, progress monitor on grade level.
- o If TDI Maze Percentile Score =  $21^{st} 30^{th}$  percentile, progress monitor one grade below the student's current grade level.
- o If TDI Maze Percentile Score =  $20^{th}$  percentile or below, progress monitor two grades below the student's current grade level.
- o Only one passage per 20 instructional days.
